## Does the Committee need an attendance policy?

Boards and Commissions established by City ordinance and appointed by the City Council tend to have provisions resulting in automatic forfeiture of office for frequent, unexcused absences. For example:

- Columbia Vision Commission three consecutive unexcused absences or four unexcused absences from regular meetings during a calendar year
- Mayor's Council on Physical Fitness unexcused absences from 50% of regular meetings in a calendar year
- Convention and Visitors Advisory Board unexcused absences from 25% of regular meetings or three consecutive unexcused absences in a calendar year

The chair has authority to excuse an absence when notified before a meeting takes place. When a position is forfeited, the chair notifies the City Council and Council members act to fill the vacancy.

Committees established by Council resolution and appointed by the City Council tend NOT to have provisions relating to attendance

## **Committee considerations**

- The Vehicle Stop Committee is established and appointed by the Interim Police Chief
- At this time, the Committee's length of operation is not defined
- At this time, the Committee has no continuing experience with member attendance
- There is an expectation that Committee members will devote the time needed to their charge
