may join an **inclusive organization** rather than *a restrictive one* that *prohibits* members from *representing their neighborhood interests*.

will be **invited to participate equally** rather than be *discouraged from engagement as an unwelcome contributor.*

And the ECTNA will continue to **advocate for neglected issues** within the East Campus Community, including **safer lighting** and **member communication with the City of Columbia**.
