# Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the annual Harvest Hootenanny Fundraising Event.

### Discussion

Billy Polanksy, Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture, has requested a waiver from the requirement of section 16-185 of the City Code for Smith Street, between College Avenue and Fay Street, beginning October 6, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. and ending at 8:00 p.m., to hold the annual Harvest Hootenanny fundraising event.

The City Event Committee has reviewed and approved the associated street closure for the proposed area with conditions to ensure safety for event-goers and the public. Mr. Polansky has met all requirements set forth in Chapter 24 of the City Code as it relates to special event permits.

The City Event Committee will continue to work with Mr. Polanksy and Kristin Frazier to ensure a safe, successful event.
