Council Bill No. B 11-18

AN ORDINANCE

authorizing the filing of electronic reports and the execution of agreements with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Electronic Reporting Rule; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, in October 2015, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency published the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Electronic Reporting Rule [80 FR 64063]; and

WHEREAS, Rule 80 FR 64063 directs any facility with an NPDES permit that requires monitoring and reporting to begin submitting associated reports electronically on the dates established in the Rule; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency notified the City of Columbia of the requirement that the annual biosolids report for the Columbia Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant must be submitted electronically using the "NeT" electronic reporting tool.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or the Manager's appointed designee, is authorized to prepare and file electronic reports with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Electronic Reporting Rule [80 FR 64063], and execute such agreements or affirmations as may be required to electronically file such reports.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
