Re: Authorizing an Agreement with Job Point for Vocational Training

Executive Summary

The attached resolution authorizes an agreement for \$24,000 in Council Reserves for Job Point to provide vocational training programs to serve persons referred to the Alternative Sentencing Courts from the Boone County Circuit Court.

Discussion

At the September 19, 2016 City Council meeting, City Council approved the transfer of \$24,000 of the remaining FY16 Council Reserves, to fund scholarships for students referred from the Boone County Circuit Court Alternative Sentencing Courts. This resolution authorizes an agreement with Job Point to proceed with utilizing funds for this purpose. Primary programs to be funded include heating, ventilation and air conditioning; highway and heavy construction; and construction and general carpentry. Specific certifications will be earned and each client will serve a four-week internship.
