Re: Agreement with Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for Healthy Families Program

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, for the Healthy Families program, in the amount of \$88,707.00, for the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

Discussion

This a renewal of a contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, for the Healthy Families program, an evidence-based community home visitation model serving at-risk pregnant women and families with young children. The goals of the program are to build and sustain community partnerships to systematically engage overburdened families in home visiting services; cultivate and strengthen nurturing parent child relationships; promote healthy childhood growth and development; and enhance family functioning by reducing risk and building protective factors. Authorization to enter this agreement will allow the program to operate at its current capacity.
