Re: Neighborhood Watch Funding Agreement

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for council consideration a resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between City of Columbia, Missouri and Neighborhood Watch of Columbia, Missouri to provide one-time funding for their program.

Discussion

This agreement will provide a one-time payment of \$2,500 in Fiscal Year 2021 to help fund the Neighborhood Watch program. The funding will be used to encourage neighborhood involvement and participation towards a goal of crime free prevention in the neighborhoods of Columbia, Missouri.

This agreement will expire on 9/30/21.
