Executive Summary

Authorize the City Manager to execute a right of use permit with Boone County, Missouri, on behalf of its Office of Emergency Management, to install and maintain a warning siren with supporting infrastructure within a portion of the Pergola Drive right-of-way (see attached exhibit).

Discussion

Boone County, Missouri, on behalf of its Office of Emergency Management, is requesting approval of a right of use permit to install and maintain a warning siren with supporting infrastructure within the Pergola Drive right-of-way. The warning siren will be constructed at a location on the south side of Pergola Drive, between South Rolling Hills Road and Old Hawthorne Drive West (see exhibit A).

Boone County Missouri, Office of Emergency Management will not obstruct or block any City street or sidewalk during construction without first obtaining permission from the City. The right of use permit agreement outlines the responsibilities of Boone County Missouri, Office of Emergency Management.
