Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Show Me Healthy Women Contract Amendment #01

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment #01 to the Program Services Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Show Me Healthy Women program. The contract amendment amount shall not exceed \$9,400 for the period of June 30, 2015 through June 29, 2016.

## Discussion

This contract allows the Department of Public Health and Human Services to provide breast and cervical cancer screening services to women who meet age and financial eligibility criteria. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) has already reimbursed the Department of Public Health and Human Services with these funds. DHSS was late in getting this amendment sent out, and at this point, signing the amendment is merely a "clean-up" to assure the appropriate paperwork was in place by DHSS.
