**AN ORDINANCE**

amending Chapter 24 of the City Code to establish a public inconvenience fee for extended temporary occupancy of public spaces; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 24 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 24-41. Required.

(a) No person shall construct, reconstruct, repair, alter or grade any sidewalk, curb, curb cut, driveway or street on the public streets or rights-of-way without first obtaining a permit from the director of public works.

(b) No person shall close a public sidewalk, parking lane, traffic lane or alley in connection with a construction project without first obtaining a permit under this division if the sidewalk, parking lane, traffic lane or alley is to be closed for thirty (30) days or less. If the sidewalk, parking lane, traffic lane or alley is to be closed for more than thirty (30) days, article IV should be followed.

(c) For public sidewalk, parking lane, traffic lane or alley closures exceeding seven (7) days, the following fees will be required:

<u>Sidewalk/curb usage</u> .....	<u>\$0.20 per linear foot per day</u> <u>(unless the walkway is covered)</u>
<u>Parking lane usage</u> .....	<u>\$0.30 per linear foot per day</u> <u>only if used as a staging area and not for vehicle use</u>
<u>Traffic lane usage</u> .....	<u>\$0.35 per linear foot per day</u>
<u>Alley usage</u> .....	<u>\$0.02 per linear foot per day</u>

A seventy percent (70%) fee reduction factor will be granted if the public sidewalk, parking lane, traffic lane or alley is opened between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday and twenty-four (24) hours on Saturday and Sunday.

Fees shall be paid prior to authorization of the closure and before a certificate of occupancy is issued.

Seven (7) day closures for the same project area are allowed only once every six (6) months to prevent multiple week-long closure requests.

Public entities will be exempt from the fee requirement. Public entities are defined as follows:

- (1) Any state or local government;
- (2) Any department, agency, special purpose district, or other instrumentality of a state or states or local government.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
