Re: Authorize an Airport Aid Agreement for Air Service Development for Columbia Regional Airport.

Executive Summary

Authorize the City Manager to execute an Airport Aid Agreement with the Missouri Highways & Transportation Commission (MHTC) to reconstruct Taxiway connectors A, A1, A2, and portions of Runway 2-20.

Discussion

In an effort to assist with financial aid related to the construction of a new terminal at the Columbia Regional Airport, MHTC has agreed to provide fifty percent (50%) of the City's local ten percent (10%) match required by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the Runway 2-20 isolated repairs project. Therefore, staff is requesting that Council authorize the City Manager to execute the Airport Aid Agreement with MHTC that will allow the reimbursement in the amount of \$229,863.00.

The designation of this grant does not create a lump sum quantity contract, but rather only represents the amount of funding available for qualifying expenses. The release of all funding under the Airport Aid Agreement is subject to review and approval by MHTC of all project expenses to ensure that they are qualifying expenses.
