Re: St. Louis County Prescription Drug Monitoring Program User Agreement

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign a User Agreement between St. Louis County and the City of Columbia to remain a member of the St. Louis County Department of Public Health prescription drug monitoring program.

## Discussion

This User Agreement authorizes the City of Columbia's participation in the St. Louis County Department of Public Health's prescription drug monitoring program (PDMP).

St. Louis County has contracted with Appriss to use a web-based PDMP platform called PMP AWARxE. St. Louis County provides access to appropriate users in the City of Columbia and operates and maintains a PDMP website with relevant information for prescribers, dispensers, the public, and participating counties. St. Louis County maintains email communication and responds to all questions, comments, and/or concerns related to the PDMP.

St. Louis County has grant funding to cover our cost, there will be no participation costs through September 2022. City of Columbia is responsible for community engagement and outreach for the program.
