AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 2 of the City Code to reduce the number of members on the Mayor's Council on Physical Fitness and Health; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-358. Membership; terms of office; officers; rules and procedures.

The mayor's council on physical fitness and health shall be composed of ~~seventeen (17)~~ thirteen (13) members appointed by the city council. If feasible, members should include persons in the following categories: education; health care; business and labor; communications and media; volunteer organizations; sports organizations and clubs; and coaches, trainers, prominent athletes, and sports administrators. Members shall be appointed to three (3) year terms and shall serve without compensation. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be for unexpired terms only. The mayor's council shall elect from its members a chair, vice-chair and a secretary. The chair shall preside at all meetings, and in the absence of the chair or the chair's inability to reside, the vice-chair shall preside. The secretary shall keep a permanent record of the proceedings of the mayor's council. The mayor's council on physical fitness and health may establish its own rules and procedures.

Sec. 2-359. Meetings; quorum; attendance.

The mayor's council on physical fitness and health shall meet every other month and at the call of the chair. ~~Seven (7)~~ Nine (9) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The chair is authorized to excuse any member from attendance at a meeting; provided, that the member requested to be excused before the meeting. Any member who is absent, without being excused, from fifty (50) percent of the regular board meetings held in a calendar year shall automatically forfeit the office. It shall be the duty of the chair to promptly notify the city council of the vacancy.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
