Adam Beckett, Global First Responder, has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code, from 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on June 7, 2018.

The City Event Committee has reviewed and approved the closure of the alley between Walnut and the Landmark Bank Parking lot and the alley between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Streets on this date for this date, provided the applicant utilizes MUTCD approved street closure barricades to block the roadways and obtaining the corresponding liquor licensing.
