Re: First Last Mile Valet Service

#### **Executive Summary**

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement for services between First Last Mile Valet Service and the City of Columbia, MO.

#### Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. This agreement with First Last Mile Valet Service addresses one of the priority areas, workforce development/support. Under this agreement, First Last Mile Valet Service will provide safe and affordable transportation services. It will create partnerships with local businesses and educational institutions and later, nonprofits and health care entities. In the second phase of the program, it will provide "car counseling" to help riders understand credit, insurance, and the actual cost of car ownership. The agreement is for \$413,663 and will end on January 31, 2027.

#### Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: This would issue \$413,663 for a project which is funded with City ARPA funds.
