A RESOLUTION

authorizing the Finance Director to write off certain uncollectible receivables.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council accepts the Finance Director's report of uncollectible service accounts as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the Finance Director to write off the official books and records of the City \$174,148.90 in miscellaneous receivables in excess of five (5) years old that the Finance Director has determined to be uncollectible. These receivables include items associated with airport fees, bankruptcy, construction dumping, excessive false fire alarm calls, health permits, landfill fees, parking fees, park facility rental, railroad fees, re-inspection fees, sewer and solid waste fees, special assessments, street sign damage, street flooding damage, and trash/appliance haul-off fees.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall not be construed as extinguishing any debt owed to the City of Columbia.
