as certified and signed by the surveyor on December 28, 2023, located on the on the northeast corner of Richland Road and Grace Lane (5401 E. Richland Road). Hereafter the property may be used for the permitted uses set forth in the revised statement of intent.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves the terms and conditions contained in the revised statement of intent, for that portion of the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance, dated December 22, 2023, marked "Exhibit A," which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance and replaces the uses established by Ordinance No. 017723 and passed by the City Council on June 16, 2003, and it shall be binding on the owners until such time as the Council shall release such limitations and conditions on the use of the property.
