Re: Grant Renewal – FY2024 Youth Alcohol Enforcement Grant

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of the Youth Alcohol Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$14,000.00 from the Missouri Department of Transportation; and authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

Discussion

This grant provides overtime funding for off duty officers and underage buyers to conduct compliance checks details enforcing underage drinking laws.

This contract period is October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The grant provides reimbursement for overtime and part-time temp pay; no matching funds are required. This was budgeted in the FY24 budget.

Long-Term Impact: 12-month grant, no anticipated cost for years beyond two.
