### **Executive Summary**

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a contract amendment with PayIt LLC for a payment processor services.

#### Discussion

This is an amendment to the City's current contract with PayIt to add web payment services for Parking Tickets (Remit/Clancy), as well as Permits/Licenses (EnerGov/EPL) to PayCoMo. There will be a \$0 net increase to the current contract.

As a reminder, The City of Columbia Finance department implemented the Paylt Enterprise Platform in July of 2023. Paylt is a "software as a service" provider of digital government services and payments. Paylt simplifies doing business with government agencies by consolidating hundreds of services and payments into one connected experience for citizens. The implementation started with replacing the payment processor for utility billing. Finance plans on looking at implementing Payit into all or most of its current online payment processors.
