A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for proposed installation of LED sports field lighting on Football Field #4 and Soccer Field #3 at the Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed installation of LED sports field lighting on Football Field #4 and Soccer Field #3 at the Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area was held by the Parks and Recreation Department on June 19, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on July 17, 2017. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed installation of LED sports field lighting on Football Field #4 and Soccer Field #3 at the Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvements shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of the proposed improvements is \$250,420.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for the proposed improvements shall be made from park sales tax funds, revenue generated from a temporary cellular tower located in the Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area, funds received from a grant agreement with the United States Soccer Federation Foundation, Inc. and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvements specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.


