Re: Authorizing an Agreement with Boone Electric Cooperative for Electric Service at Fire Station #11.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute an electric service agreement with Boone Electric Cooperative to provide electric service to Fire Station #11.

Discussion

Fire Station #11 is currently being constructed to service the south side of the city limits. The fire station is located within the electric service territory of Boone Electric Cooperative. This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to execute the electric service agreement with Boone Electric Cooperative. This agreement is similar to other electric service agreements between the City and Boone Electric Cooperative.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The minimum cost for electric is \$112.50 per month (\$1,350 annually), which will be paid from the Fire Department operating budget.

Long-Term Impact: The ongoing minimum annual cost of \$1,350 for electric service for this fire station will be included in the Fire Department annual operating budget.
