- 1.1     The contract amount shall not exceed \$365,420.00 for the period of February 1, 2024 through January 31, 2025.

In addition, the Department of Health and Senior Services desires to amend the above-referenced contract in accordance with the following:

- 1.     Add Section 14.4 in its entirety as follows:
