

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of the Antimi Sports Complex improvement project; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of the Antimi Sports Complex improvement project was held by the Parks and Recreation Department on April 3, 2017 and April 4, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on October 16, 2017. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of the Antimi Sports Complex improvement project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City. Specific improvements include replacing existing chain-link fencing, expanding dugouts, installing irrigation and spectator shade structures, constructing ADA walkways and maintenance access drives in the complex, and constructing two new batting cages and four new bullpens.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvements shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of the proposed improvements is \$450,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for the proposed improvements shall be made from 2015 Park Sales Tax funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvements specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
