

A RESOLUTION

declaring the necessity for construction of improvements to the Columbia Police Department (CPD) facility located at 600 E. Walnut Street, more specifically to include security upgrades, ADA compliance improvements and renovation of building space and equipment replacement; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the improvement; providing for payment for the improvement; providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law; and setting a public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council deems the construction of improvements to the Columbia Police Department (CPD) facility located at 600 E. Walnut Street, more specifically to include security upgrades, ADA compliance improvements and renovation of building space and equipment replacement, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 2. The nature and scope of the improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$795,000.00.

SECTION 4. Payment for this improvement shall be made from Downtown Police Building Renovation Capital Improvement Project funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. Any work done in connection with the construction of the improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.

SECTION 6. A public hearing in respect to this improvement will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on June 20, 2016. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.
