Re: Transferring Funds from the Storm Water Utility to the Sewer Utility for Joint Purchase of a Dump Truck

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution transferring \$27,923 from the Storm Water Utility to the Sewer Utility.

Discussion

During the FY15 budgeting process, the Sewer and Storm Water Utilities agreed to jointly purchase a tandem axle dump truck as a supplemental item. A transfer of \$27,923 from the Storm Water Utility to the Sewer Utility is needed to cover the cost of the vehicle. This transfer will allow the two utilities to share ownership, maintenance and use of the vehicle.
