Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the annual Marcassin Drive Neighborhood Block Party.

## Discussion

Mike Serpico has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code on October 7, 2017, from 3:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. to hold a neighborhood block party. There will be no alcohol sales or distribution; neighbors may pass through street with open containers while attending other neighbor's properties.

The City Event Committee has reviewed and approved the closure of Marcassin Drive from Greengate to Old Hawthorne on this date for the event, provided the applicant utilizes MUTCD approved street closure barricades to block the roadways.
