Re: North East Community Action Corporation (NECAC) Contract for Provision of Title X Family Planning Services

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign the Contract for Provision of Title X Family Planning Services between the City of Columbia and North East Community Action Corporation (NECAC) for the period of April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018 in the amount of \$14,608.

Discussion

This contract allows the Department of Public Health and Human Services to provide family planning services to low income, uninsured and underinsured women. While the contract period is April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, NECAC is only providing six months of funding at this time. This program is funded through the federal government, and the funding agency is unwilling to commit to funding past September 2017 pending potential impacts from the yet-to-be passed FY 2018 federal budget.
