Re: Appropriating Funds to Scott Boulevard Phase III Project for Public Infrastructure Improvements associated with the Construction of the New Beulah Ralph Elementary School

## Executive Summary

Staff is appropriating funds received from Columbia Public Schools, to the Scott Boulevard Phase III project, for public infrastructure improvement upgrades associated with the construction of the new Beulah Ralph Elementary School.

## Discussion

At the July 7, 2014 Council meeting, Ordinance 22107 authorized the City Manager to execute a development agreement with Columbia Public Schools that identified and allocated costs for upgraded public infrastructure improvement upgrades associated with the construction of the new Beulah Ralph Elementary School. Improvements included construction of at-grade pedestrian crossing across Scott Boulevard at Abbington Terrace, flashing school zone indicators on Scott Boulevard, intersection improvements at Scott and Route KK consisting of a roundabout, sidewalks, signing, lighting and utility relocations, totaling \$483,346.37. Attached is a breakout of costs associated with the infrastructure improvements.
