Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Program Services Contract for Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity Enhancing Detection Expansion

### Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment 02 of the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Enhancing Detection (ED) Expansion Grant for the period of July 1, 2021 through July 31, 2024. The contract amount shall not exceed \$946,680.

### Discussion

The purpose of this agreement is to assist with providing or implementing COVID-19 response activities. Public Health and Human Services will use these funds for public health surveillance, including data analysis and reporting; and health education and information activities to reduce the spread of COVID-19. This Agreement extends the end date to July 31, 2024.
