Re: Temporary Waiver from the Requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to Allow

Possession and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the 2019 Fortune Fest event.

Discussion

Mike Nolan, General Manager of Rose Music Hall, has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code from noon until 11:00 p.m. on August 17, 2019. The estimated attendance for the event is 1,500 people.

For the past two years, the City Event Committee has approved the closure of Park Avenue in front of Rose Music Hall for this event. The setup for this year's event appears to be the same in years past. Conditions of approval have included use of barricades that are compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) to block the road closure area and procurement of required liquor licensing and insurance. The city's Special Event Permit application has been completed and approved.
