**AN ORDINANCE**

repealing Section 4 of Ordinance No. 024211 to lift the temporary waiver relating to the payment of transportation fares; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 024211 on April 6, 2020 to provide, in part, for a temporary waiver in the collection of payment for transportation fares; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health and Human Services issued Order No. 2020-07, Reopening Plan – Phase 2, Step 3, with an effective date of June 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the reopening plan issued by the Director, the City Council desires to repeal Section 4 of Ordinance No. 024211 to lift the temporary waiver relating to the payment of transportation fares.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Repeal of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 024211. The City Council hereby repeals Section 4 of Ordinance No. 024211 passed on April 6, 2020, to lift the temporary waiver relating to the payment of transportation fares.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
