Re: Appropriate Funds for the Cosmo Tennis Court Improvement Project

Executive Summary

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting approval of an ordinance to appropriate \$40,000 from Park Sales Tax annual park improvement funds for the Cosmo Tennis Court Improvement Project. The project is a major maintenance project to renovate the four tennis courts on the south side of the tennis complex at Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area (a.k.a. Cosmo Park). The project has been submitted to City Council as an Administrative Public Improvement Project under a separate report. The project details are included in that report.
