Re: Authorizing the acquisition of easements for construction of the Nebraska Avenue Stormwater Improvement Project

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the acquisition of easements necessary for the construction of the Nebraska Avenue Stormwater Improvement Project, as shown on the attached diagrams. A public hearing was held on March 20, 2023.

## Discussion

The Nebraska Avenue, Stormwater Improvement Project, will replace the existing undersized storm drainage infrastructure in the Nebraska Avenue Right-of-Way with 335 feet of 8-foot x 3-foot reinforced concrete box conveyance and add eight (8) inlets and 150 feet of 18-inch pipe to reduce the incidence of street flooding. In addition, some of the channel downstream of the system outlet will be stabilized to prevent further erosion and protect the improved storm system. See the attached Project Graphic.

The project will require the acquisition of seven (7) temporary construction easements (TCE) and three (3) permanent drainage easements (PDE) from five (5) property owners. See individual project graphics of the proposed easements to be acquired.

Construction plans are 90% complete with construction expected to begin in 2024.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The resolution estimate for this project is \$1,100,000, and will be paid from Stormwater Utility funds and ARPA grant funding.

Long-Term Impact: Minimal to reduced impact on Stormwater Utility's annual operating budget.
