Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Hepatitis A Outbreak Contract

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Hepatitis A Outbreak Contract for the period of December 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. The contract amount shall not exceed \$5,424.

## Discussion

Missouri is currently experiencing a Hepatitis A outbreak. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services is making funding available to select local public health agencies to assist in covering personnel and medical supply costs associated with this outbreak. Payments will occur to cover costs associated with the outbreak response. While the outbreak has not yet surfaced in Columbia, it would be most efficient to have the contract in place so that if/when Columbia does need to respond to outbreak cases, we can immediately start invoicing for our costs, according this contract.
