Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of the Youth Alcohol Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$24,400.00 from the Missouri Department of Transportation; and authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

Discussion

This grant provides overtime funding for off duty officers to conduct compliance checks details enforcing underage drinking laws.

This contract period is October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

Fiscal Impact
