Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the annual Harvest Hootenanny event.

Discussion

Billy Polanksy has requested a waiver from the requirement of section 16-185 of the City Code for Smith Street between College Avenue and Fay Street beginning October 7, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. and ending at 8:00 p.m., to hold the annual Harvest Hootenanny fundraising event.

The City Event Committee has reviewed and approved the associated street closure for the proposed area with conditions to ensure safety for event-goers and the public. Mr. Polansky has met all requirements set forth in Chapter 24 of the City Code as it relates to special event permits.
