

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 150-20

**A RESOLUTION**

authorizing staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Stewart Road, Edgewood Avenue and Westmount Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #30); directing that a public hearing be held upon completion of the preliminary plans.

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2012, the City Clerk received petitions for the formation of a private common collector elimination (PCCE) project from certain property owners on Stewart Road, Edgewood Avenue, Westmount Avenue and Parkway Drive; and

WHEREAS, City's Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division identified the private common collector sewer main that serves the Stewart Road, Edgewood Avenue, Westmount Avenue and Parkway Drive area to be in poor structural condition; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary estimated cost of the proposed Stewart Road, Edgewood Avenue and Westmount Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #30) is \$400,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Stewart Road, Edgewood Avenue and Westmount Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #30).

SECTION 2. Upon completion of the preliminary plans for the proposed Stewart Road, Edgewood Avenue and Westmount Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #30), the City Council further directs that a public hearing be held in respect to this improvement.
