Re: Authorizing the Temporary Restriction of Driving Lanes and Closure of Sidewalk and Parking by the Staat Tuckpointing and Waterproofing, contractor for the University of

Missouri, to complete work at the Power Plant along East Stewart Road.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing Staat Tuckpointing and Waterproofing, contractor for the University of Missouri, to temporarily restrict driving lanes and close the north sidewalk and south parking lane of East Stewart Road to complete work at the MU Power Plant between South Fourth Street and South Fifth Street from July 19, 2023 through August 17, 2023.

Discussion

The traffic impacts of East Stewart Road between South Fourth Street and South Fifth Street from July 19, 2023 through August 17, 2023 include:

- Both driving lanes will be shifted to the south.
- Closure of the north sidewalk.
- Closure of the south parking lane.

Staff authorized a 30-day restriction for the driving lanes and closure for the parking lane, and sidewalk beginning June 19, 2023. Staat Tuckpointing and Waterproofing, contractor for the University of Missouri, will be completing work at the MU Power Plant. Staff has reviewed the attached traffic control plans and has no other issues with their request.

The University of Missouri owns all of the property adjacent to the closure.

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
