Re: Council request for additional REDI board members

Executive Summary

At the request of council, staff has prepared a report recommending a change in council representation on the REDI board.

Discussion

As time has gone by and new members have been added to the REDI board, the City of Columbia has seen its voting proportion diluted. Given our financial support to REDI, staff recommends the addition of two ex-officio board members to bring council board membership back into proportion with what it once was. The requested ex-officio board members would be in addition to the memberships already held by the City Manager and Mayor. It is also requested that the ex-officio board memberships rotate yearly to different council wards (e.g. year one would comprise wards 1 and 2; year two would comprise wards 3 and 4; etc.).
