

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 70-18

A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of the vehicular lanes and eighteen (18) parking spaces on Seventh Street between Locust Street and Elm Street, and the sidewalk on the south side of Elm Street between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, to facilitate the installation of utilities and the rehabilitation of steam chases and manholes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the University of Missouri to close the vehicular lanes and eighteen (18) parking spaces on Seventh Street between Locust Street and Elm Street, and a portion of the sidewalk on the south side of Elm Street between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, as shown on "Exhibit A," from May 15, 2018 to August 10, 2018 to facilitate the installation of utilities and the rehabilitation of steam chases and manholes.

SECTION 2. The University of Missouri shall close those portions of the street, parking spaces and sidewalk only in accordance with the closure plan submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying the University of Missouri, in writing, of such requirements. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the street, parking spaces and sidewalk due to any damage caused by the construction activity. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. The University of Missouri shall proceed with construction activities which require the street, parking space and sidewalk closures without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary street, parking space and sidewalk closures authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination such closures are no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.
