A RESOLUTION

granting temporary waivers from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 100 feet for two (2) Ninth Street Summerfest events.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants temporary waivers from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage shall be allowed for the area along a portion of Ninth Street between Walnut Street and Broadway during two (2) Blue Note Ninth Street Summerfest events on the following dates and times:


- 1. May 20, 2022 – 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- 2. July 15, 2022 – 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby grants a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-258 of the City Code so that amplified sound exceeding a distance of 100 feet for the area along a portion of Ninth Street between Walnut Street and Broadway shall be allowed during two (2) Blue Note Ninth Street Summerfest events on the following dates and times:

- 1. 7:00 a.m. on Friday, May 20, 2022 to 1:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 21, 2022
- 2. 7:00 a.m. on Friday, July 15, 2022 to 1:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 16, 2022
