Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Rural PrEP Clinic Program Contract Amendment 01

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to the Rural PrEP Clinic Program Contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the period of August 1, 2024 through May 31, 2026 in an amount not to exceed \$80,000 for the period of June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026.

Discussion

The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Rural PrEP Clinic Program agreement supports the development and implementation of rural Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) offerings tailored to ending the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) epidemic. The program increases HIV screening and re-screening among patients at elevated risk for HIV, expands access for people seeking HIV preventative services and increases PrEP coverage where access is limited.

The amendment will allow PHHS to continue to cover the cost of PrEP associated labs, sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing, office visit costs, supplies, and staff time. Additionally, with these funds PHHS will continue to offset the expense (0.5 FTE) of existing nursing staff to provide increased availability of PrEP services in the PHHS clinic.

This grant was included in the FY2025 budget. No appropriation is needed.
