Executive Summary

IAFF Local 1055 and City staff have completed discussions and agree to a renewal of the provisions of Ordinance 22670 (B345-15). No revisions have been made to the provisions agreed to for 2016.

Discussion

The proposed work ordinance is a renewal of the provisions agreed to in Ordinance 22670 (B345-15) in December 2015. There are no revisions except for the effective date. The current ordinance expires December 31, 2016.
