Re: Cooperative Agreement for Radio Consulting Service and Single Site Repeater

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign a cooperative agreement between County of Boone, MO and the City of Columbia, MO for radio consultant services and single site repeater at Columbia Regional Airport.

## Discussion

The proposed agreement with Boone County, Missouri would allow City staff to consult with Boone County staff to discuss and install a single repeated radio channel in accordance with FAA regulations at the Columbia Airport. This new channel would replace the existing short ranged system and provide coverage for the entire Airport at no cost to the City.

In return for the new repeater, the City of Columbia agrees to assign the existing frequency to the County by way of Assignment of Authorization filed with the FCC, to address system wide radio interference.
