Executive Summary

At the request of the City Council, an ordinance amending Chapter 2 of the City Code as it relates to the name, purpose, and objectives of the Substance Abuse Advisory Commission has been prepared for consideration.

Discussion

At the April 1, 2024 meeting, the City Council made a motion to request staff to prepare an ordinance to amend Chapter 2 of the City Code as requested by the Substance Abuse Advisory Commission. The ordinance would change the name of the commission to Substance Use Prevention Advisory Commission. It also updates the purposes and objectives of the commission to utilize modern terminology with respect to proactive language focused on prevention as opposed to abuse.
