**A RESOLUTION**

authorizing Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. the temporary closure of a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street; granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet for the area associated with an outdoor event.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants a Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. to temporarily close a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street, associated with an outdoor event on May 2, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through May 3, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby grants Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet, along a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street beginning on May 2, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through May 3, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
