

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of a sidewalk along the north side of St. Charles Road between Demaret Drive and Battle Avenue; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an online interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of a sidewalk along the north side of St. Charles Road between Demaret Drive and Battle Avenue was held by the Public Works Department from May 26, 2020 through June 8, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on July 6, 2020. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of approximately 3,100 linear feet of sidewalk along the north side of St. Charles Road between Demaret Drive and Battle Avenue necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the following:

1. Construction of a five-foot wide concrete sidewalk with grass parkway along the north side of St. Charles Road between Demaret Drive and the entrance to Lake of the Woods Golf Course.
2. Construction of a six-foot wide concrete sidewalk with concrete curb and gutter along the north side of St. Charles Road from the Lake of the Woods Golf Course driveway to north of Battle Avenue.
3. Installation of a crosswalk with a pedestrian flashing beacon at the intersection of St. Charles Road and Demaret Drive.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$688,600.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from funds received from the Columbia Public Schools per the terms of a cost allocation agreement, Capital Improvement Program sales tax funds, City/County/State joint tax funds, and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
