

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: The Sinclair Road Sidewalk at Muirfield project will include construction of a 5-foot wide concrete sidewalk along the east side of Sinclair Road. The sidewalk will tie the existing sidewalk at the southeast corner of the Sinclair and Muirfield intersection to the existing sidewalk approximately 660-linear feet south of Muirfield along Sinclair. The sidewalk will be constructed in existing street right-of-way. Staff will utilize a City term and supply contract to complete construction of the project. Construction is planned for this summer.

Department: Public Works

Estimated cost: \$48,600

Funding source: 1/4 cent CIP Sales Tax

Project meets the following criterion (check one):

- Construction, upgrade or relocation of electric distribution lines less than sixty-nine (69) KV that is estimated to cost less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
- Water and electric production facility expansion projects estimated to cost less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00).

No tax bills will be issued for the project.
Project does not require exercise of power of eminent domain.
