(b) Definitions. The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this section shall have the following meanings, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

~~Distribution conduct. An exchange which requires an acceptance or rejection of the item being distributed between a person located in a major corridor roadway and an occupant of a vehicle operating on a major corridor roadway.~~

...

(d) Prohibitions.

...

(6) ~~No occupant of a vehicle being operated on a major corridor roadway shall engage in distribution conduct with a pedestrian standing in or entering upon a major corridor roadway. Nothing contained herein is intended to prohibit:~~

- a. ~~Distributing anything to or accepting anything from occupants of a lawfully parked vehicle;~~
- b. ~~Distributing anything to or accepting anything from occupants of a vehicle adjacent to a sidewalk if the person accepting or distributing remains at all times on the adjacent sidewalk; provided, however, the vehicle may not obstruct or impede moving traffic in order to engage in distribution conduct with a person standing on a sidewalk; or~~

- c. ~~Parking and exiting a vehicle to distribute anything to or accept anything from another person on a public sidewalk.~~
- a. No person shall intentionally cause or require a vehicle to stop, stand, or maneuver in a travel lane of a major corridor roadway in a manner that impedes traffic flow or creates an immediate traffic hazard, except where such stopping is otherwise required by traffic control devices or congestion.
- b. No occupant of a vehicle shall stop or stand a vehicle in a travel lane of a major corridor roadway in a manner that creates an immediate traffic hazard, except as required by traffic control devices or emergencies.
