

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Public notice is hereby given that the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, Missouri (the "Authority") will hold a public hearing in the board room at the offices of the Authority, 201 Switzler Street, Columbia, Missouri 65203, on Thursday, September 28, 2017, commencing at 10:00 a.m., at which time any person may be heard regarding the proposed plan of financing for the bonds described below.

The Authority will consider the proposed issuance of its multifamily housing revenue bonds in one or more series in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,300,000 for the purpose of making a loan to Bryant Walkway II Housing Development Group, LP, a Missouri limited partnership (the "Partnership"), to finance a portion of the costs of the acquisition and rehabilitation of approximately 36 apartment units in 9 buildings located at 306-412 LaSalle Place, 306-402 Pendleton Walkway, 200 Boone Drive, 300-304 and 304A Trinity Place and 201-203 and 203A Park Avenue in the City of Columbia, to be known as Bryant Walkway II Apartments (the "Project"). The Partnership is expected to be the owner and operator of the Project.

The hearing will be open to the public. All interested persons may attend the hearing and will have an opportunity to express their views with respect to the Project, including the location and nature of the proposed facilities and the issuance of bonds to pay the costs thereof. Written comments with respect to the Project may also be submitted to the undersigned prior to the hearing. Additional information regarding the proposed Project and the bond issue may be obtained in advance of the hearing from the undersigned. The Authority makes reasonable accommodations for any known disability that may interfere with a person's ability to participate in public meetings. Persons needing an accommodation must notify the Authority, by telephone at the number below or in writing at the address below, no later than five days prior to the hearing to allow adequate time to make needed arrangements.
